DUST-PROOFING

The RM is compiling a list of rural property owners who wish to receive dust-proofing for 2011. The minimum distance for the application is 300 feet with payment to be received in full prior to the application.

LOT MAINTENANCE

Please ensure that all empty lots are maintained and kept free of tall grass/weeds & garbage on a regular basis. Unmaintained village lots will be cleaned up without prior notice at a charge to the property owner.
(\$100.00 plus tax)

GRAVEL RECOVERY PROGRAM

This spring The Municipality will again begin the gravel recovery program which involves retrieving gravel from road sides for placement on the road. Material brought up from the sides onto the road is mulched however residents are cautioned to drive with care during this time. The gravel recovery program saves the municipality tens of thousands of dollars in gravel costs each year. The RM is appreciative of your understanding and patience during this process.

WEED CONTROL

The Municipality is planning to hire a contractor to spray ditches for weeds this year. The spraying would be done in June and primarily 2,4-D will be used. Property owners with any concerns should notify the Municipality.

OFF-ROAD VEHICLES

Please be reminded that there are restrictions on all off-road vehicles.

Under *The Drivers and Vehicles Act* this includes, but not limited to: snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles, mini-bikes, dirt bikes, amphibious vehicles, etc. These vehicles are intended for use on an owner's private property and not to interfere with the quality of life of others.

These vehicles are not allowed on any sidewalk, road, ditch, or any other public property.
