BUILDING PERMIT APPLICATIONS

Planning on building or renovations this spring?

Starting April 1st all permits for work being done in the RM of Stanley will be accepted only at the municipal administration office during regular office hours (Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm).

Dust-proofing

The Public Works Dept. is compiling their list of rural property owners who wish to receive dust-proofing for 2013. The minimum distance for the application is 300 ft with the cost remaining at \$1.00/lineal ft. **Registration and full payment MUST be received in the office on or before May 10th to receive the dust-proofing application.**

Lot Maintenance

Please be reminded that all empty lots/properties must be maintained on a regular basis and kept free of tall grass, weeds and garbage. Unmaintained properties may be cleaned up without prior notice at a charge to the property owner.

Weed Control

The weed spraying program is continuing for 2013 in municipal ditches. Property owners with any concerns or questions should contact the Public Works Department.

Gravel Recovery Program

Residents are urged to drive with caution as the municipality begins the annual gravel recovery program this spring. The program saves tens of thousands of dollars each year and we appreciate your understanding and patience during this process.
