Fire Departments in Winkler and Morden would like to remind residents of the importance of proper installation, cleaning and maintaining of chimneys when using wood burning appliances or alternative heat sources. When making calls to the Fire Departments it is important to give your current civic address.

Rural property owners should give the number posted at your residence along with your road number (Example: 1111 Road 12W).

Rural Mailboxes

Canada Post will be centralizing mail delivery service throughout certain rural areas of the Municipality by installing community mailboxes. This is in response to Canada Post's safety concerns for mail pickup/delivery and road maintenance concerns for the Municipality. Community mailboxes will allow you to safely pull to the side of the road to access your mail and will include an outgoing mail slot.

If your area is being selected to receive community mailboxes, you will be notified by Canada Post.

PFRA Shelterbelt Program

If you are a rural landowner of 5 acres or more and your property is zoned agricultural you are eligible to apply for trees through this program.

The program provides seedlings for the establishment of shelterbelts in rural areas. The seedlings are provided at no charge when the application is approved. Eligible applicants are responsible for seedling transportation costs, planting, and maintenance.

Notice of Water Rate Increase

The water rate for those residents receiving water from the Pembina Valley Water Co-op has increased by \$0.13 per thousand gallons to \$8.75 per thousand gallons. This is a pass-through increase by the Pembina Valley Water Co-op. The new rate is effective as of January 1, 2012.
