2013 Taxes are due on Wednesday, October 30th, 2013.

By now all residents should have received the 2013 tax statement(s). For those of you who have not received your statement(s) please call the administration office for your copy or if you have any questions related to a statement.

Payments options include cash, cheque, debit (in-person), or on-line through your banking institution (allow 5 business days for processing). An after-hours drop-off box is located at the municipal office. Credit cards are NOT accepted. Be sure to include your roll number or the bottom portion of your statement to ensure proper accounts are credited.

If you have sold a property in the past year and have received a statement in error, please forward it to the new owner. Please contact your lawyer to confirm which party is responsible for payment. The statement is mailed to the owner on file as of the mailing date.

An interest penalty of 0.83% per month will be applied to all overdue accounts not received in the administration office before the due date.

Manitoba Farmland School Tax Rebate

The Farmland School Tax Rebate was implemented in 2004 through the Province of Manitoba to support the rural economy by providing farm landowners with school tax relief.

The province has implemented a \$5000.00 cap on the rebate for 2013 and you must also be a resident of Manitoba to be eligible.
