DOGS

Public Works Report

Some of the work and projects the public works department has been busy with:

Repairing roads and replacing culverts due to damage from spring run off and moisture conditions.

Various road upgrade projects:
(23W, 25W, 9N, Friedensruh)

Water expansion projects— approximately 30 water connections added

Weed spray program covered over 900 miles of ditches
Dust proofing of roads and streets (286,000 liters of material applied)

Drainage program—over 1,000 hours of excavator time

POLICING

Residents are encouraged to report any suspicious activity to the local RCMP detachment at 822-4476 as soon as possible. It is important to pass on any information so that the RCMP have a record of the incident.

911 should only be used in emergency situations at which time you will be required to know your civic address. This number is:
A) In a village - the house no. & street name.
B) Outside of a village - the combination of the marker at the end of your driveway AND the road number your driveway is located on (i.e. 12088 Road 23W).

DID YOU KNOW ?

The Municipality is named in honor of Baron Stanley, the Governor General who donated the Stanley Cup to the National Hockey League.

Stanley is 18 miles x 18 miles in size (207,300 acres), of which 83% is considered prime agriculture land.

Approximately 50,000 yards of gravel are used each year to maintain over 400 miles of all-weather road.

The RM utility operates over 1250 water connections which consumed 78,791,804 gallons in 2010.

WATER METER READINGS/ NON-READ FEES

Every 3 months water meter readings are required by The Municipality (end of March, June, Sept., Dec.). Receiving these readings in a timely manner is essential to identifying and avoiding problems with your water account.

In the event that a reading is not received by the date specified a \$5.00 non-read fee is charged and a minimum 3000 gallons is billed to your account. This often increases the next quarter's bill. If no reading is received three quarters in a row, a non-read fee of \$40.00 will be charged to your account.

Please keep your account current as outstanding balances 60 days past due will be added to the tax roll for the property.
