OCTOBER 2012

2012 TAXES are due on Tuesday, October 30th, 2012.

Payment options: cash, cheque, debit (in person) or on-line through your banking institution. Credit cards are NOT accepted. There is an after hours drop-off box at our administration office for your convenience. Be sure to include your roll number(s) or the bottom portion of your tax statement(s) to ensure proper accounts are credited. For on-line payments allow 5 business days for processing.

An interest penalty of 0.83% per month will be applied to all overdue accounts not received in the administration office before the due date.

Property ownership maps are available for purchase at the RM administration office.

The maps are updated on a regular basis and provide property owners names on the map. If you wish to have your name removed from the map, please contact the RM administration office.

Tax bills are sent to the owner(s) listed as of the mailing date.

If you have sold a property in the Municipality in the past year and have received the tax statement for that property, please forward it to the new owner. Please contact your lawyer to confirm which party is responsible for payment of the 2012 taxes.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

Roads Report:

Extremely dry conditions this summer/fall have led to some deterioration of gravel roads. Please use caution as loose gravel can make for poor handling of vehicles. Use extreme caution when approaching heavy equipment and be aware of uncontrolled intersections as tall crops and dust can hamper your ability to see approaching traffic. As winter is approaching we ask that all fence lines on shoulders of municipal roads be removed by October 1st to allow for winter snow clearing.

Driveways:

A reminder that new driveway installations & driveway extensions onto Municipal roads require RM approval. Decorative culverts should be constructed in a manner that does not interfere with snow removal/road maintenance equipment. Please call 325-4101 to review with RM staff prior to construction.

Walkways:

By Provincial regulation, motorized vehicles are not allowed on any walkways to ensure the safety of all pedestrians. We ask that homeowners with property fronting a walkway ensure that trees near walkways are kept trimmed to keep the walks passable. Please do your part to help keep our walkways safe and enjoyable for residents.

Drainage:

Please be reminded that all private drainage work **MUST** be licensed by MB Water Stewardship. The RM public works staff can assist you with this process.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation throughout the summer as RM public works crews completed a number of projects throughout the Municipality.
