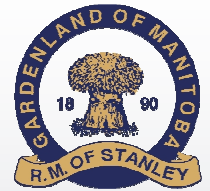

#### 2013 TAXES are due on Wednesday, October 30th, 2013.

Payment options: cash, cheque, debit or on-line through your banking institution. Credit cards are NOT accepted. There is an after hours drop-off box at our administration office for your convenience. Be sure to include your roll number(s) or the bottom portion of your tax statement to ensure proper accounts are credited. For on-line payments allow 5 business days for processing.

An interest penalty of 0.083% per month will be applied to all overdue accounts not received in the administration office before the due date.

Tax bills are sent to the owner(s) listed as of the mailing date. If you have sold a property in the past year and have received the tax statement for that property please forward it to the new owner. Please contact your lawyer to confirm which party is responsible for payment of the 2013 taxes.

Visit our website for an explanation on how to read your tax statement or to find more information on assessment, credits/rebates, budget, and so on.

#### PERMITS/LICENSES REQUIRED

Please be advised that a permit is required before the installation of the water line to your dwelling. Contact administration staff for fees or to discuss payment options.

Drainage on private property must be licensed by MB Water Stewardship. RM public works staff can assist you with this process.

Building permits must be approved before any construction has begun. A conditional use, variation order or re-zoning may be necessary due to regulations or zoning requirements. Contact the administration office with any questions or to find out which documents are required.

#### PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

Public Works remains busy with regular maintenance and projects. As winter approaches we would like to remind residents of several issues:

- 1) **Fences within 15 feet of the road edge must be removed before winter.**
- 2) **Decorative culvert and driveway structures must be marked well to avoid damage from snow clearing equipment.**
- 3) **Snow from driveways must be kept on private property and is not to be pushed across roadways.**
- 4) **If you have given the municipality permission in previous years to do snow ridging but would not like us on your property this year, please call public works.**
- 5) **All private mailboxes must be removed.**
- 6) **Bales, dirt piles, equipment and the like should be stored well away from the Right of Way to avoid snow from drifting across roadways.**

Thank you for your cooperation in making this coming winter a safe one.
